

2-Person Best Ball Rules Sheet

Tees:

Gross Flight- Blue Tees 1 of 2 GROSS Best Ball

Net Flight – White Tees 1 of 2 NET Best Ball

Women's Flight – Red Tees 1 of 2 NET Best Ball

- Lift Clean and Place in your own fairway (the fairway of the hole you are playing) one club length no closer to the hole.
- Please keep a good pace of play. Stay up with the group in front of you.
- USGA rules are in effect.
- Dropping – Make sure to drop from knee height when dropping a ball into play. If a ball is dropped incorrectly, a player has the opportunity to correct the mistake prior to the stroke being made. If the mistake is not corrected, the player will incur a one stroke penalty.
- Uses of distance measuring devices are allowed.
- Flagstick – Once the flag has been removed on the green, it needs to stay out until all players have putted out for safety on blind shots and pace of play.
- Ground Under Repair: is designated by white lines or ropes encircling the area of any construction, newly seeded or sodded areas, water damaged areas, or damaged areas in the closely mown areas through the green. Interference occurs when the ball lies in, or touches the condition or when the condition interferes with the player's stance or the area of his intended swing. Relief in the general area is one club-length of and not nearer the hole than the nearest point of relief.
 - Drop area on hole 18 for any ball that crosses the cart path between hole 1 tee and 10 tee
- If there is any doubt as to the proper ruling or procedure in stroke play only, play a SECOND BALL in accordance with Rule 20.1c, and obtain a ruling from the committee upon completion of the round. You must declare you are playing a second ball to your fellow competitors before proceeding, and must declare which score you would like to count if the rules permit. The competitor must report the facts to the committee before signing the scorecard. If he fails to do so, he is disqualified.
- In the case of bad weather, the horn will be blasted once to suspend play; Resuming play will be denoted with two short blasts.
- If the tournament does not complete 18-holes. The score will be based on the number of holes completed by the entire field.
- **Decision of Ties:** Only first place ties will be broken. In the event of a tie, a playoff will start immediately; the tournament director will determine starting hole. Playoff format is sudden elimination; net or gross score based on the flight, wins the hole.
